Court Street, Athens Ohio **until 10:00 A.M., Tuesday, July 19, 2016**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Said bids are for 600 tons, more or less, of Portland Cement for use by the Athens County Engineer. The products offered are required to meet or exceed ODOT specifications.

Plans, specifications, proposals, and estimated quantities may be obtained or examined at the office of Jeff Maiden, P.E., P.S., Athens County Engineer, 16000 Canaanville Rd, Athens, Ohio on weekdays, excluding holidays, between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 3:30 P.M. local time.

Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope with the name of the Bidder and the name of the Proposal written on the outside of the envelope.

INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

- I. All Proposals must be in a sealed envelope and marked on the outside as "**Bid for Cement**", along with the name and address of the bidder.
- II. The bidder is required to fill in all blank spaces in ink and shall indicate a unit price bid for each item of the proposal. The unit price will be used to determine the low bidder. It is estimated that approximately 600 tons may be required for the CR 20 base stabilization project. The material will be delivered in enclosed pneumatic trailers with the ability to unload themselves using blowers, loading into custom spreader trucks.
- III. The contracting authority reserves the right to waive any irregularities in the bidding procedure that are not in conflict with the Revised Code of Ohio.
- IV. Successful bidder must provide Material Safety Data Sheets for each type of material supplied.

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SPECIFICATIONS

Material shall consist of Portland Cement conforming to State of Ohio, Department of Transportation Specifications for Portland Cement, Item 701.04.

701.04 Portland Cement. Provide portland cement according to ASTM C 150, Type I. The Gillmore time of set and the air permeability (fineness) tests will govern.

Delivery will be made to the project site on Athens County Road 20 – East Scatter Ridge Road. The material shall be delivered in enclosed pneumatic trailers with the ability to unload themselves using blowers, loading into custom spreader trucks.

It is estimated that approximately six hundred (600) tons of cement could be purchased under this contract, with the exact amount determined by actual road surface area.

Unit prices shall remain firm until October 31, 2016 and payment for delivered material will be made within 30 days after receipt of statement.
